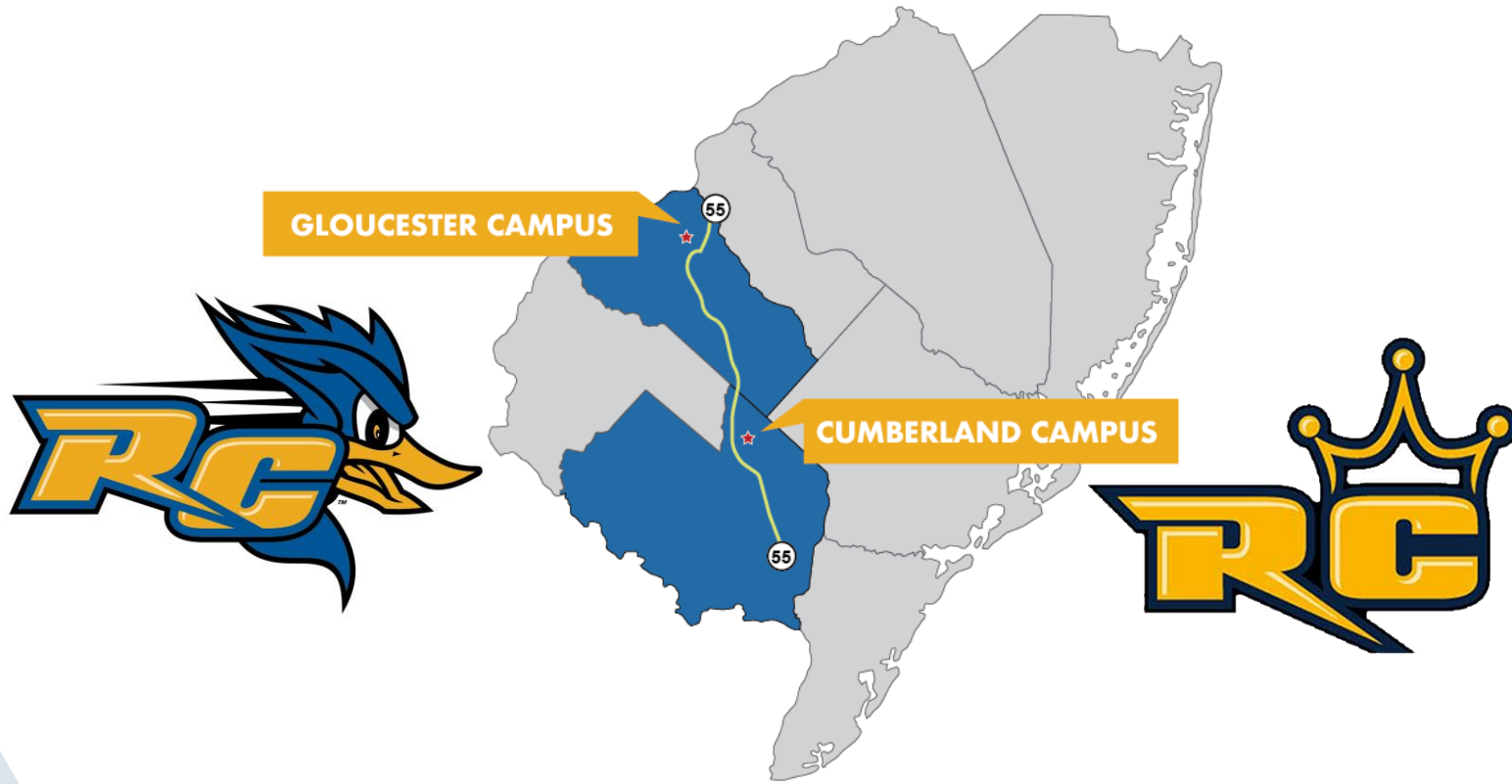

# Attend RCSJ Your Way



## Face-to-Face

- Students attend class in a physical classroom on campus
- Instructors and students interact in a shared space
- Instructors may use eLearning to supplement course content or assignments



## Hybrid

- A mix of online, live online, and traditional face-to-face
- No more than 50% of course work is done online
- Includes both synchronous and asynchronous learning

## Online

- Students attend class and complete all work entirely online via eLearning
- Instructors provide support and provide content to read, watch, or interact with online
- Students are not required to be online at a specific time or from a specific place (asynchronous)



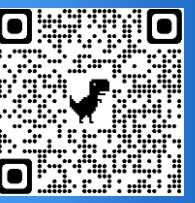
## Live Online

- Students attend class online at specific times via a web-conferencing platform
- Participate in real-time interaction with instructors and classmates

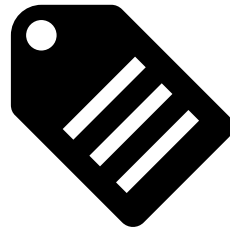
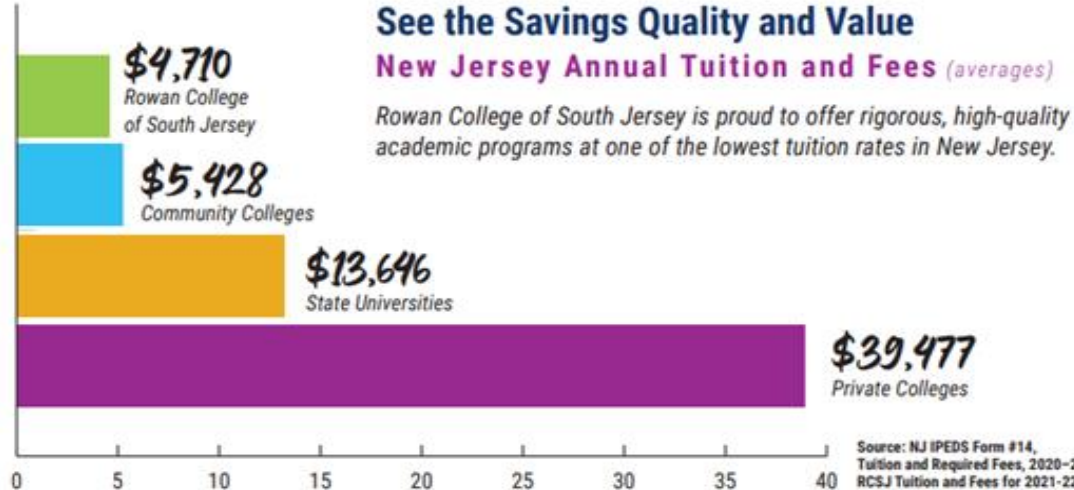
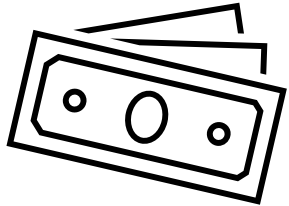

## CCOG Details and Information

### **Community College Opportunity Grant eligibility:**

- New Jersey resident with Adjusted Gross Income between \$0 - \$80,000
- Completed FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application by applicable state deadlines
- Enroll in at least six (6) credits per semester at one of our community colleges
- Have not yet earned a college degree
- Make satisfactory academic progress

# Enrollment Steps – 1: Apply



- Visit [www.rcsj.edu/apply](http://www.rcsj.edu/apply) and choose your desired campus!
- Students can attend either campus, regardless of residence
- **Both applications are available now!**
- Check your email for acceptance letter & info on accessing the student portal



# Enrollment Steps – 2: Financial Aid



- [Submit your 2023-24 FAFSA](#) (nationwide)
- [Submit your 2023-24 HESAA](#) (statewide)
- Both applications open October 1st, 2022!
- Both applications are based on 2021 taxes
- You must include **RCSJ FAFSA code: 006901**
- For assistance with filing, visit [www.rcsj.edu/financialaid](http://www.rcsj.edu/financialaid) or ask your school counselor for workshop availability
- Always follow up with your Financial Aid department for additional requirements



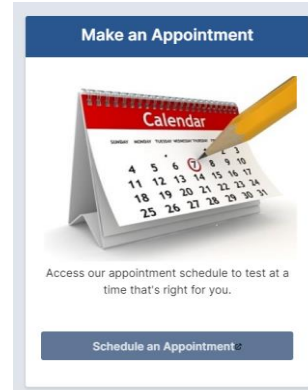
# Enrollment Steps – 3: Testing



## Submit Existing Standardized Scores:

- SAT
- ACT
- NJSLA (ELA 11)
- NJSLA (Algebra II)
- Accuplacer (taken in high school)

## Take the Accuplacer Placement Exam:



- Visit [www.rcsj.edu/testing](http://www.rcsj.edu/testing) and click “Schedule an Appointment.”
- First attempt is free. Students can pay \$10 to challenge each section.

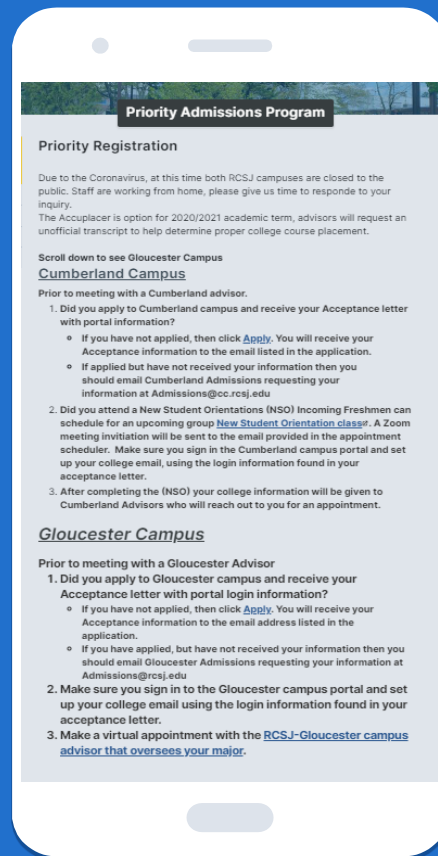
# Enrollment Steps – 4: Registration

# Enrollment Steps – Overview



Month	Steps
<b>Now</b>	1.) Apply for admissions and submit your transcript.
<b>Now</b>	2.) Apply for financial aid.
<b>January-March</b>	3.) Satisfy testing requirements.
<b>April-May</b>	4.) Meet with academic advisor and register for courses.
<b>August</b>	5.) Pay your bill.
